Carpenter Foundation Scholarship Criteria for Applicant

- 1. This application is used in awarding the Carpenter Foundation Scholarship to a graduating Butte Falls High School student or graduate from Butte Falls Charter School attending college.
- 2. To be eligible for this scholarship an applicant must have received a grade point average of 3.0 cumulative over their four years of high school. A borderline G.P.A. will be considered where special circumstances exist along with the recommendation of the school officials. A college student that is reapplying must have maintained a creditable record at the college or university they have been attending.
- 3. Other criteria which will be considered before awarding the scholarship are:
 - Evidence of need.
 - Good citizenship and good moral character.
 - A written 300-word essay stating your post high school goals, objectives and participation in high school/community activities. Include the most significant community service activity that you have been involved in.
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation. One from your high school principal or teacher. One other recommendation letter from community member/employer.
